Students seeking a Minor in Sociology must complete 21 credit hours.

Required Courses:

- SOC 101 Introduction to Sociology
- SOC 201 Social Issues
- SOC 202 Race and Ethnicity
- SOC 301 Social Research
- SOC 302 Social Theory

Electives:

Students seeking a minor need to take six credits of electives. Three credits may be any non-required sociology course or one of the following: PSYC 224 Social Psychology, BUEC 121 Microeconomic Principles, BUEC 122 Macroeconomic Principles, or HIST 116 Global Geography. The other three credits must be a 300-level sociology course.
