

1. Go to <http://sat.collegeboard.org/scores> to see your scores. SAT scores come out online at 5 a.m. on the day that scores are released.
2. Approximately 5 days after the initial scores come out, the 10-page score report PDF comes out (it's usually on a Tuesday). This is the document that you should email to us.
