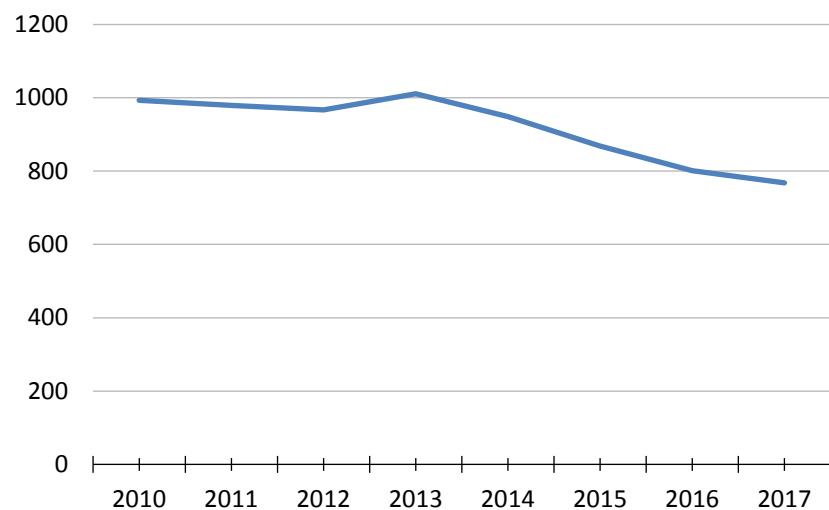

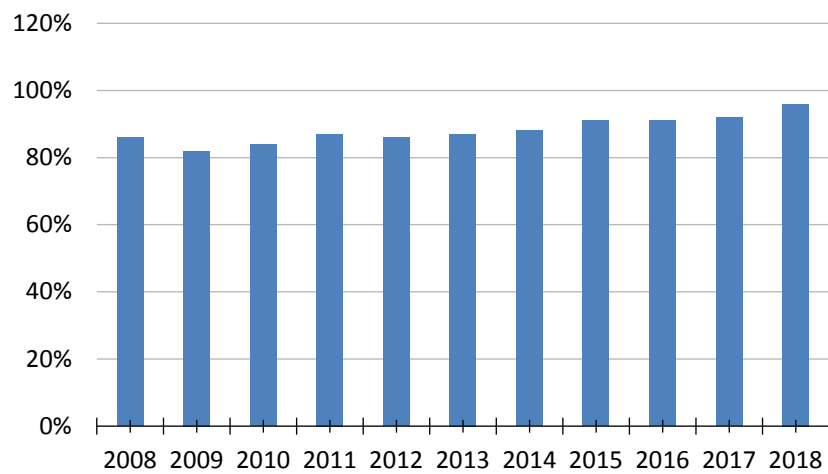

Fall Enrollment Full and Part-Time Undergraduate Students



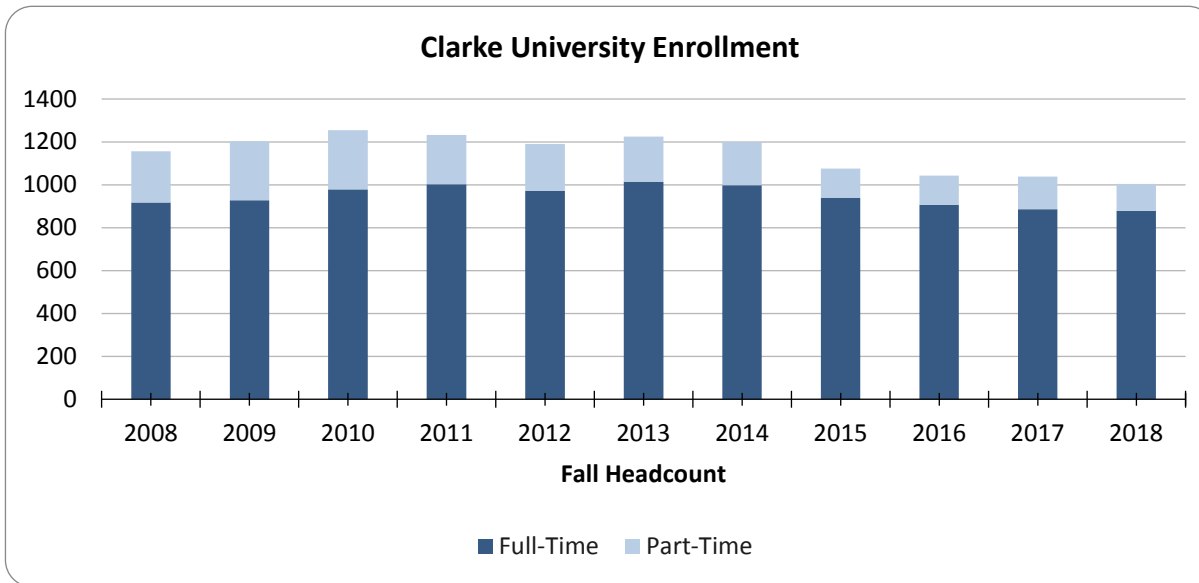
Percentage of Fall Enrollment Consisting of Full-Time Students

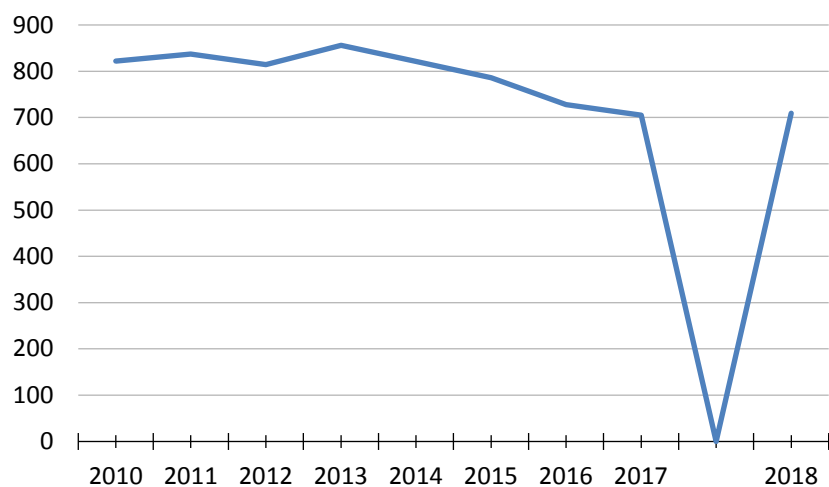

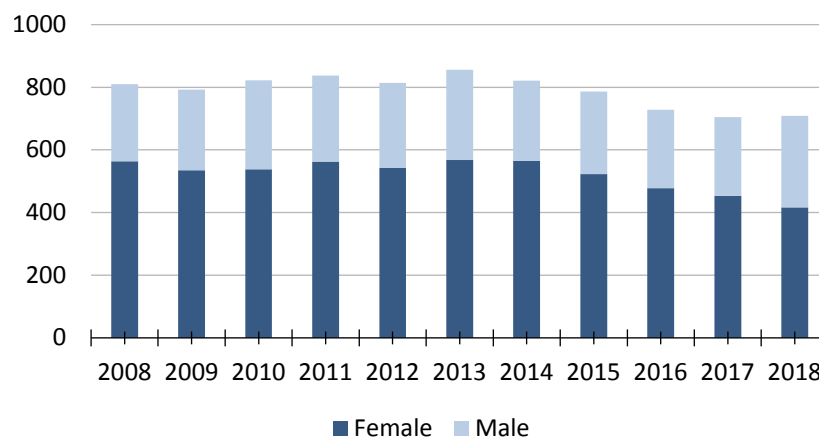

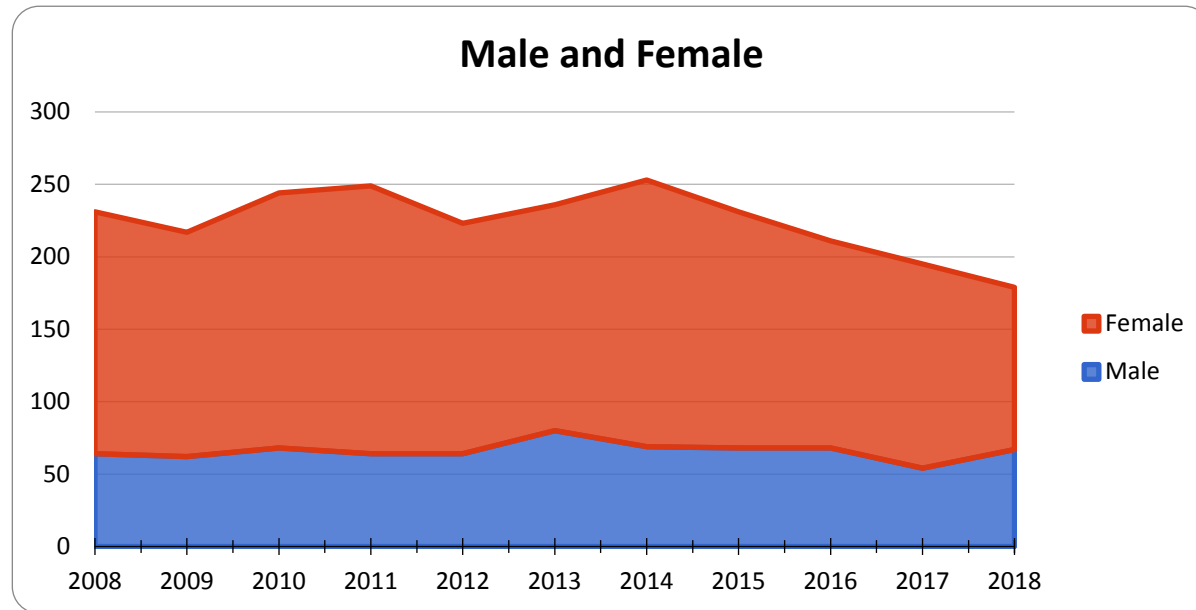


Full-Time Degree-Seeking Undergraduates by Gender

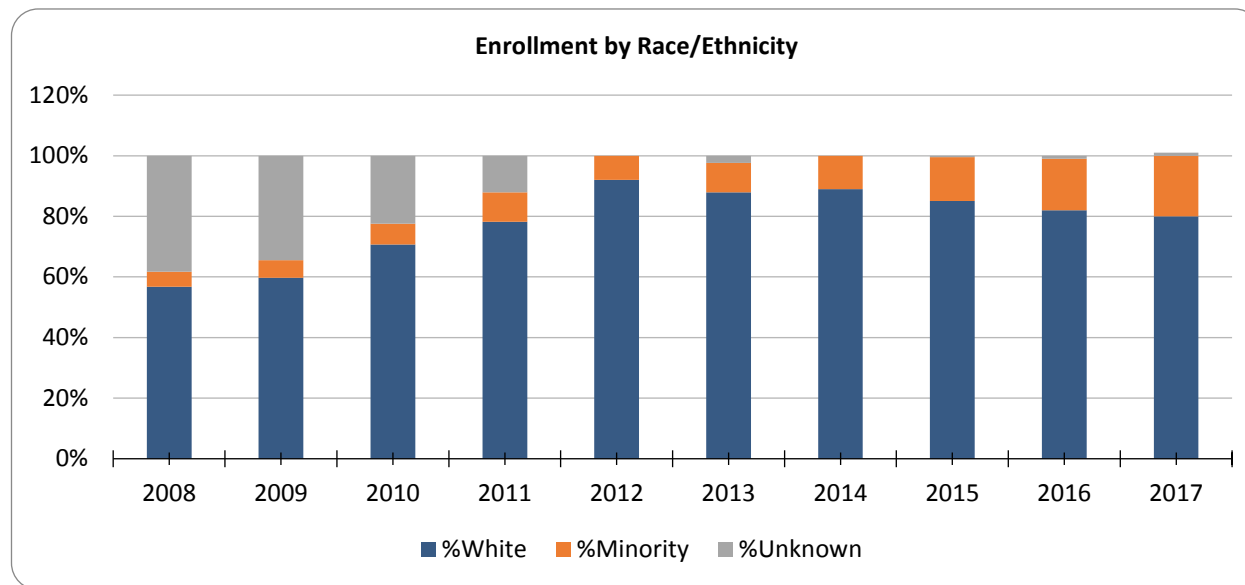
