- Ministered to this secular, state university of 11,000 students

- Managed the Newman House and developed it from a facility used once a week into one used 24/7 by the students for spiritual, educational, recreational, and community activities
- Implemented bible studies, men's and women's ministries, and new student retreats that became foundational for developing community among students
- Established the student-run Rocky Mountain Awakening retreat for colleges in the southern half of Colorado, which resulted in students becoming more engaged in their faith and added to the number of active students in the ministry
- Coordinated weekly campus Mass, scheduling presiders, liturgical ministers, and local families to cook community dinners after Mass; growing mass attendance from the teens into the forties and consistently hosting over 20 students at dinners
- Directed the Alternative Spring Break Program, establishing a relationship with a local non-profit to take college students and local parish youth on annual trips to El Salvador with a focus on solidarity, cultural exchange, and healthy, sustainable, loving service
- Collaborated with an ecumenical group of CMU Christian campus ministers called "Common Ground" to support one another and host "Meat the Freshmen", an annual event where 10 campus ministries cook and feed over 500 students steak dinner to show the love of Christ
- Involved university staff / faculty in the ministry via small groups, bible studies, advisory board, and at events such as Last Lecture Series, Theology On Tap, and Dinner and Discourse
- Ran the campus ministry RCIA program and assisted local parish programs
- Managed the ministry budget and raised funds for ministry projects and activities by donor solicitation (over \$10,000) and grant writing (over \$15,000)
- Expanded the technological footprint of the ministry through social media, website development, advertising (Adobe Photoshop), and online fundraising
